Walking between Terminals is easy. All SFO Terminals are connected by Walkways which provide a healthy alternative to AirTrain.

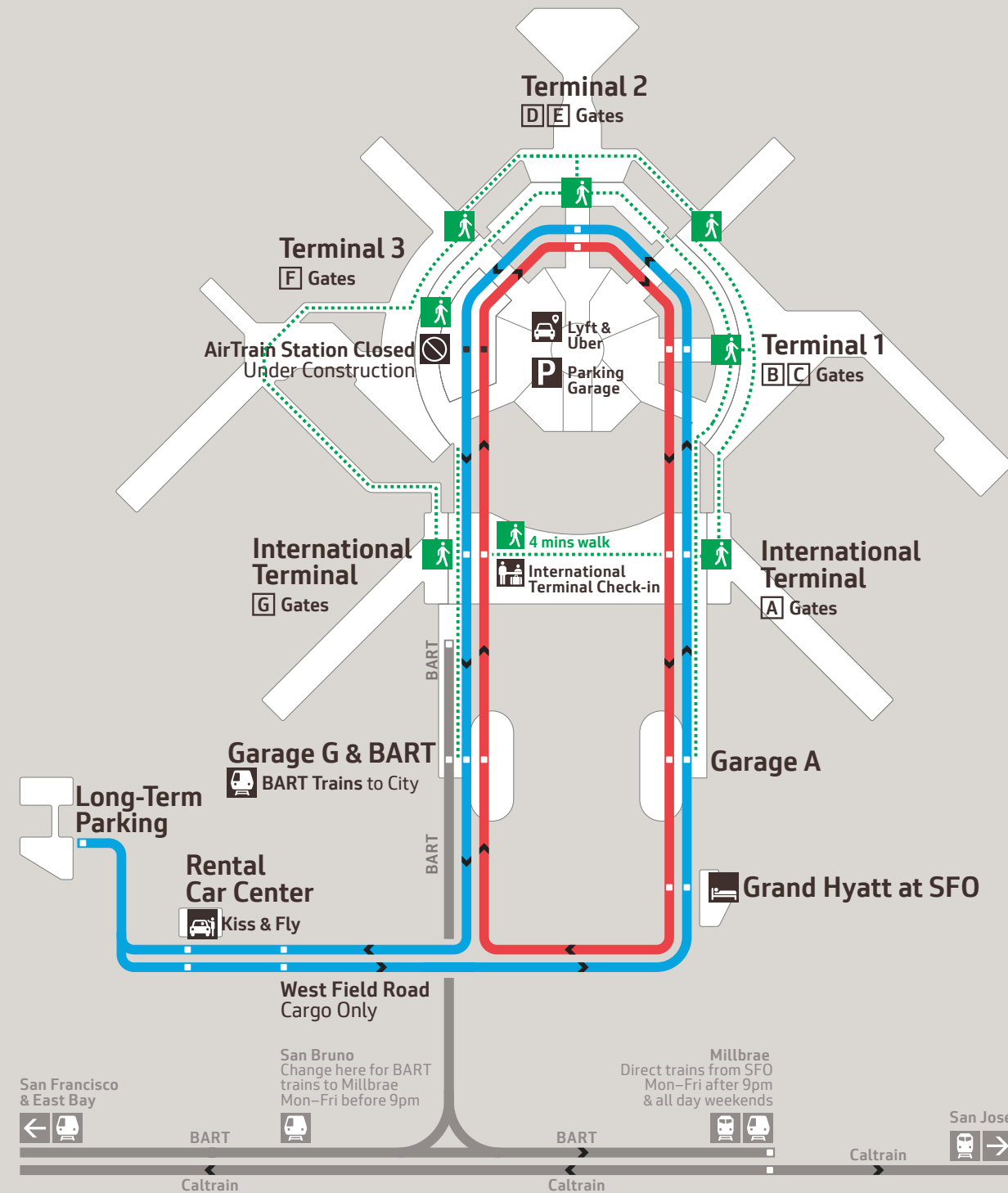


AirTrain Connections

SFO's AirTrain provides year-round service 24 hours a day. AirTrain connects All Terminals, Garages and Rental Car Center with stations.

The average journey time between terminals by Walkway is 6 minutes.

The average journey time between terminals by AirTrain is 3 minutes.

Ground Transportation

Getting to and from SFO is very easy. Whatever your travel plans, we have convenient options to get you on your way.

BART Trains to City & Millbrae

BART Rapid Rail connects SFO to San Mateo County, San Francisco and the East Bay. The SFO BART Station is located in the International Terminal.

Caltrain

Caltrain provides rail service between San Francisco and San Jose. Caltrain via BART. Change at Millbrae BART Station.

Frequency	At least once an hour	
Operates	Weekdays	5am–midnight
	Weekends	8am–10pm

Lyft, Uber & Wingz

Terminals 1, 2 & 3 – Please check your app for pickup location. For pickups on Level 5 of the Domestic Garage follow signs to Parking Garage. International Terminal – All pickups take place on Level 3 Departures center island.

SamTrans Buses

SamTrans provides 24-hour bus service connecting SFO with San Mateo County & parts of San Francisco.

Frequency	At least once an hour	
Operates	24 hours daily

Airporter Buses

Airporters operate on fixed routes and schedules. Consult individual operators for information. Fares can be paid directly to the driver.

Hotel Shuttles

Hotel Shuttles provide a free service to participating hotels.
